EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY. The General Sessions Clerk is authorized to allow traffic offenders, who are eligible to attend TRAFFIC SCHOOL to attend the school without appearing in Sessions Court.

This authorization covers all offenders who are charged by the officer and have not been to a TRAFFIC SCHOOL in the past two (2) years and had a speed of less than twenty (20) miles per hour above the posted speed limit. Defendants must pay all fines and costs for the ticket.

The Court will further allow the State approved on-line Traffic School.

This authorization will also cover Juvenile offenders who are eligible to go to the "Teen School" at the local Mental Health Center. No court cost is to be paid by the Juvenile offenders.

The Clerk is further authorized to advise all agencies of the Court's approval of this new procedure. All eligible offenders must contact the Clerk for final approval. This procedure may help with the COVID-19 pandemic and is to be in effect until changed by the Court.
